As you will be aware, there have been some changes to the COVID-19 Protection Framework and My Vaccine Pass and vaccination mandates will be removed as from 11.59pm on Monday 4th April.

At Fairfield Primary there will be no immediate changes to our school day-to-day operations for the next couple of weeks. As there are still a large number of people in Hamilton impacted by covid, we feel our current restrictions are still the best means to keep us all as safe as possible. We will review our settings at the beginning of Term 2.

#### COMMUNICATION

Facebook is our school's preferred means of communicating notices and events. Please find us on Facebook and "like" or "follow" us to ensure you keep up to date with what is happening at school. Each class also has their own facebook group. These are closed groups for family members of students in the particular class only. If you have not already done so, please search for your child's class facebook group and request to join. If you are having difficulty finding this, please private message our school page and we will provide this for you.

Newsletters are only sent home every 4-6 weeks depending on what is going on.

Class notices are sent home as required. We ask that you regularly check your child's schoolbag for any notices and return any forms or permission slips promptly.

If you feel you may have missed a newsletter or notice, there are always spares at the office.

#### STATIONERY

#### SCHOOL HOURS 8:40am - 2:30pm

As parents and carers, it is your responsibility to make sure your child attends school every day. It is also important to ensure they are at school no later than 8:40am and remain at school until 2:30pm. Children who arrive after the 8:40am bell must report to the office to collect a late slip. This ensures they are taken off the absentees and you will not be contacted by the school. Parents of children who are consistently late will be followed up on.

Children must remain at school until the 2:30pm bell everyday unless there is a very good reason for them to be released early.

#### **ABSENTEES**

It is essential that you notify the school if your child is absent. You can text 021502978, phone 8556284 or send a note with a sibling. Fairfield Primary has a strict attendance policy. Coming to school is absolutely imperative and children should only be absent if they are sick or have a very good reason. You can expect a phone call, text or home visit if your child's absence has not been explained.

## ENROLMENT AT FAIRFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL FOR NEW STUDENTS

The Fairfield Primary School Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Fairfield Primary School for the period:

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> May - 8<sup>th</sup> July (Term 2 2022)

Enrolment at the school is governed by an Enrolment Scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

The Board has determined that a total of 7 places are likely to be available for OUT OF ZONE students in Years 1 – 6.
The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of

The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's enrolment zone.

Application forms are available from the school office.

#### The deadline for receipt of application for Out of Zone places is: 7th April 2022.

Parents who live within the home zone and who intend enrolling their child in Term 2 should notify the school office by 7th April to assist the school in planning appropriately for this period. All students in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school. The ballot only affects students who live out of zone.

If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available in each year level, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot for out of zone places is required, it will be held on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2022.
