2024 OUT-OF-ZONE **BALLOT INFORMATION**



Enrolment at Fairfield Primary School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office

The board has determined 20 places are likely to be available for out-of-zone students in 2024. The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of applications received from students who live in zone.

There will be 4 enrolment periods in 2024. The first enrolment period is for Term 1 (31st January to 12th April).

If you live out-of-zone and you wish for your child to be considered for enrolment for Term 1 2024 through the out-of-zone ballot, you will need to complete an application form. Application forms are available from the school office or can be emailed upon request

ATTENDANCE

You will most likely be aware that the Ministry of Education has had a huge focus on attendance this year.

Attendance data is collated for every child and schools are required to send through the data to the Ministry at the end of every week.

It is imperative that school is notified when your child is absent and we have been provided with the reason for absence.

Children who miss 3 or more school days in each fortnight are considered "chronically absent" and can expect home visits and/or agency intervention.
