Next week, we will be holding meetings with students interested in joining a team. Notices will be given to these students to bring home and discuss with their parent/caregiver.




Before signing permission to be considered for a team, parents/caregivers must ensure they can provide weekly transportation for their child and be fully committed throughout the entire season.
