Dear Parent / Caregiver,

As this is the first Newsletter since school resumed, we say a big WELCOME BACK. It is great to be back at school and have a little bit of normality in our lives.

Since returning, teachers have been focusing on rebuilding relationships, reminding the children of our expectations and getting back to normal classroom routines.

Good hygiene practices are here to stay and all students should be very familiar with regular handwashing, sanitising and how to stop spreading germs when they cough or sneeze.

We noticed during Level 2 that many students gained a lot more independence by being waved goodbye at the school gate. We encourage parents to continue this practise at Level 1. Staff will also continue to be at the gates to greet everyone in the morning and farewell in the afternoon.

As part of our "new normal" all entry gates except the office entry gate will remain locked during school time. As part of Health and Safety requirements, any adults coming on to the grounds after school has started, are required to walk through the office and sign in.

At the end of the day, our junior teachers will continue to take their class to the pedestrian gate to meet parents and caregivers.

Children are not to be picked up before the end of the school day unless there is a very good reason. e.g. family emergency or appointment. Convenience is not an acceptable reason. On the rare occasion you need to pick up early, you must sign the student/s out at the office.

We will be arranging regular times for parents to visit classrooms so that children will be able to show you the great work they have been doing. Teachers will also continue to post regularly on their class facebook page so you can keep up to date with what is happening in the classroom.

NETBALL

We are thrilled to have received news from the Netball centre that there will be a season this year, albeit a shortened season.

We have 3 teams entered - Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6. All teams have commenced training and are eagerly awaiting the season to start. Please note that teams were closed off last Monday as they are all full. We have a small wait list and if any further names are received they will also go on the wait list should any player or players withdraw.

BASKETBALL

We are hoping to enter a Year 3/4 and a Year 5/6 Basketball team into the Term 3 league.

Our Year 3/4 team still has 4 spaces to be filled and our Year 5/6 team still has 2 spaces available.

These spaces will need to be filled before we can register the teams.

Games are played at the YMCA or THE PEAK RECREATION CENTRE on Wednesday (Yr3/4) and Friday (Yr5/6) afterschool. Please talk to Whaea Sandy or Matua Ohlson if interested in joining a team.

ENROLMENT AT FAIRFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL FOR NEW STUDENTS

The Fairfield Primary School Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Fairfield Primary School for the period:

20th July - 25th September (Term 3 2020)

Enrolment at the school is governed by an Enrolment Scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

The Board has determined that a total of 10 places are likely to be available for **OUT OF ZONE** students during this period.
The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of

applications received from students who live within the school's enrolment zone

Application forms are available from the school office.

The deadline for receipt of application for Out of Zone places is: 25th June

Parents who live within the home zone and who intend enrolling their child in Term 3 should notify the school office by 25" June to assist the school in planning appropriately for this period. All students in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school. The ballot only affects students who live out of zone.

If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available in

each year level, students will be selected by ballot.

If a ballot for out of zone places is required, it will be held on 29th June 2020.

Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.
